

Girl Scouts of Central Texas Travel Committee Member

Position Summary: This position is responsible for helping to plan, organize, promote, and implement Girl Scouts of Central Texas (GSCTX) council sponsored trips in collaboration with other Travel Committee members and the GSCTX Girl Scout Experience Department. Travel Committee members are also responsible for supporting travel education to other adult members of GSCTX.

Accountability: Appointed by and accountable to the appropriate Girl Scout Experience Department staff member for a one-year term (October 1 – September 30).

Responsibilities:

- Attend a minimum of 70 percent of the monthly virtual meetings as determined by the travel committee members annually.
- Contribute to meetings by offering personal knowledge, contacts, and travel experience.
- Help plan, organize, and budget council-sponsored trips for Girl Scouts.
- Assist in the travel marketing through social media and other GSCTX channels.
- Ensure that GSCTX and Girl Scouts of America (GSUSA) policies, standards, and procedures (Safety Activities Checkpoints and Volunteer Essentials) are upheld.
- Be familiar with Girl Scout program resources available to both you and the Girl Scouts served.
- Use effective communication skills.
- Keep up to date on what is happening in Girl Scouts locally, nationally, and all over the world.
- Be familiar with the concepts inherent in Girl Scouting, such as youth/adult partnership, pluralism, gender equity, and positive role models.

Position Commitments:

- Be a registered adult member of Girl Scouts, have a current eligible criminal background check on file at GSCTX, and be in good standing with GSCTX.
- Accept and adhere to the purpose and principles of the Girl Scout movement and the goals of GSUSA and the Central Texas council.
- Ability and willingness to make decisions, delegate responsibility, and work with adults from diverse backgrounds.
- Knowledge of WAGGGS or willingness to learn.
- Previous or current travel experiences.
